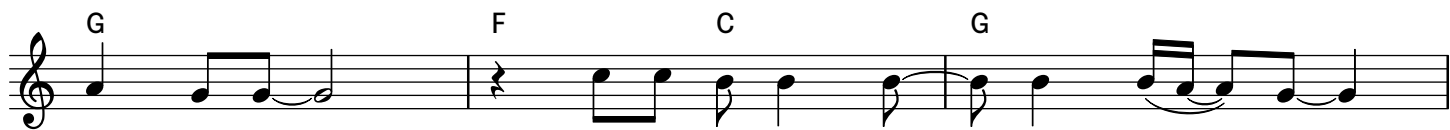


Come, Ye Sinners
